

WELCOME TO HIGH VIEW BARN

Here are a few things that you might need to know during your stay

THE DOORS

There are three doors to the outside and a set of sliding doors round the bedroom:

The main door into the living area. This is the only door that can be locked from the outside. Use the key to unlock the door and turn the handle **180 degrees** to the right to release the catch. The door then slides open.

The kitchen door can be opened in the same way by turning the handle 180 degrees and sliding it open. To lock the door simply slide closed and turn the handle back to the upright position.

The window/door to the rear patio can be opened by turning 90 degrees or can be used as a vent by turning 180 degrees. This is a **low door** so please watch your head!

The bedroom area can be closed off with a set of sliding doors. Please pull the doors **gently** to close and open again. The barn is open plan and, as it is far away from public view, many people will prefer to leave the doors open whilst sleeping.

LINEN AND TOWELS

All linen and towels are provided. If you need extra towels please help yourselves from the shelves by the stairs. There is also soap, bubble bath, shower gel and toilet paper in the bathroom. Extra toilet paper is in the cupboard under the wash hand basin. There is a hairdryer in the bedside table.

CLEANING MATERIALS

Cleaning materials and a dustpan and brush are in the cupboard under the kitchen sink.

KITCHEN

The kitchen has a large fridge/freezer.

There is **electric fan oven/grill** and the **electric hob**. The extractor fan is above the hob.

There is also a **microwave, dishwasher** and **washer/ dryer**. There is also an iron and ironing board.

Instructions for the oven, microwave, dishwasher and washing machine are in the bottom drawer next to the oven. The handle for the grill is in the drawer above this one.

On the shelves in the kitchen you will find a fire blanket and a fire extinguisher. Let's hope you do not need them!

HEATING AND HOT WATER

The barn has hot water and underfloor heating which runs on a ground source heat pump. There are two control panels one in the living room and one in the kitchen. Don't worry about the time indicated on the panel, but **make sure that the hand is visible**. This indicates that the system is working manually. You can adjust the temperature by using the up and down arrows on the panels. Please beware that underfloor heating may take a few hours to react.

There is also a **wood burning** stove. The stove draws best if you use paper and kindling to start them and keep the front doors closed with the vent fully open to the right. Please use the oven gloves provided to open and close the doors as the handles can get very hot!

LOGS

There is a **supply of wood** in the garage at the main house. The garage is in front of the house and there is a light on the right as you go in.

TELEVISION

The TV has a built in Freesat Box. You turn the TV on with the remote control then select your channels.

INTERNET ACCESS

There is a wi-fi router in the living room. The access code is on the back of the router. The wi-fi connection is free of charge.

MOBILE PHONES

Most mobile phones work pretty well. However, in the area in general, signals can be a bit hit and miss! Vodafone is the most reliable.

CAR CHARGING



There is a charger at the rear of the main house. This is for use for both occupants of Church Hill Farm and High View Barn. Please ensure that access is clear when not in use so others can access it. If you would like to use the charger please text me and I can tell you how much your charge has cost and I will invoice you accordingly. There is a fast charger at the Premier Inn in Monmouth which is on the right hand side just before the roundabout and next to the Shell Garage. It is a short walk from there into town and the charge takes about 40 minutes.

OUTDOOR FURNITURE AND BARBECUE

There is a large picnic table on the lawn outside the kitchen and a patio table and four chairs on the rear terrace. There is a barbecue but you may need to buy charcoal.

GARBAGE

Please put any biodegradable matter in the compost bin at the end of the stables by the dustbins. There are six dustbins – one for bottles, one for cans and recyclable plastic, one for card and paper and four for everything else. We will take your garbage down to the recycling depot in Monmouth.

Via M4 from London

Take **M48 exit** (shortly after the M5 exit at Bristol) across the **old** Severn Bridge and exit after the bridge onto A466 to Chepstow and Monmouth.

Continue on A466 past Chepstow racecourse and about one mile later take the B4293 on the left just after the Piercefield Pub.

Continue on this road for approx. 9 miles. You will go through Devauden, Llanishen and Trelleck. About one mile after Trelleck you will see a sign for Penallt. Turn right here taking the left fork (the right fork goes to Whitebrook). Follow this road (now single track) bearing left after "The Farm" and then immediately right until you come to a **T junction** - now turn right.

Via A40 from Oxford

If you are travelling from Oxford the A40 via Gloucester is probably a lot easier as Monmouth is on the A40 too. You can avoid Cheltenham on this route by taking the A436 / A417 via Birdlip or you can go through Cheltenham if you prefer. Both can be slow in the rush hour!! After you cross the Severn at Gloucester follow the signs to Ross on Wye and stay on the A40 after that to Monmouth. (If you prefer you can take the scenic route through the Forest of Dean by turning off the A40 onto the A4136 at the village of Huntley which is half way between Gloucester and Ross. Here there is a traffic light and sign to Monmouth. When you arrive in Monmouth using this route you turn left immediately after crossing the Wye and this will bring you back onto the A40). At Monmouth take exit to Trelleck. At the next junction bear left and within a half mile bear left again onto the B4293 up the hill towards Trelleck. Almost at the brow of the hill you will see a turning off to the left to Penallt. Turn left here. Continue up this road bearing left until **THE FINAL PART ♦♦♦**

From North via M5/A40 Monmouth

At Monmouth take exit to Trelleck. (from Ross on Wye just before the tunnel and from Newport just after). At next junction bear left and within a half mile bear left again onto the B4293 up the hill towards Trelleck. Almost at the brow of the hill you will see a turning off to the left to Penallt. Turn left here. Continue up this road bearing left until **THE FINAL PART**
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From West Wales/Cardiff

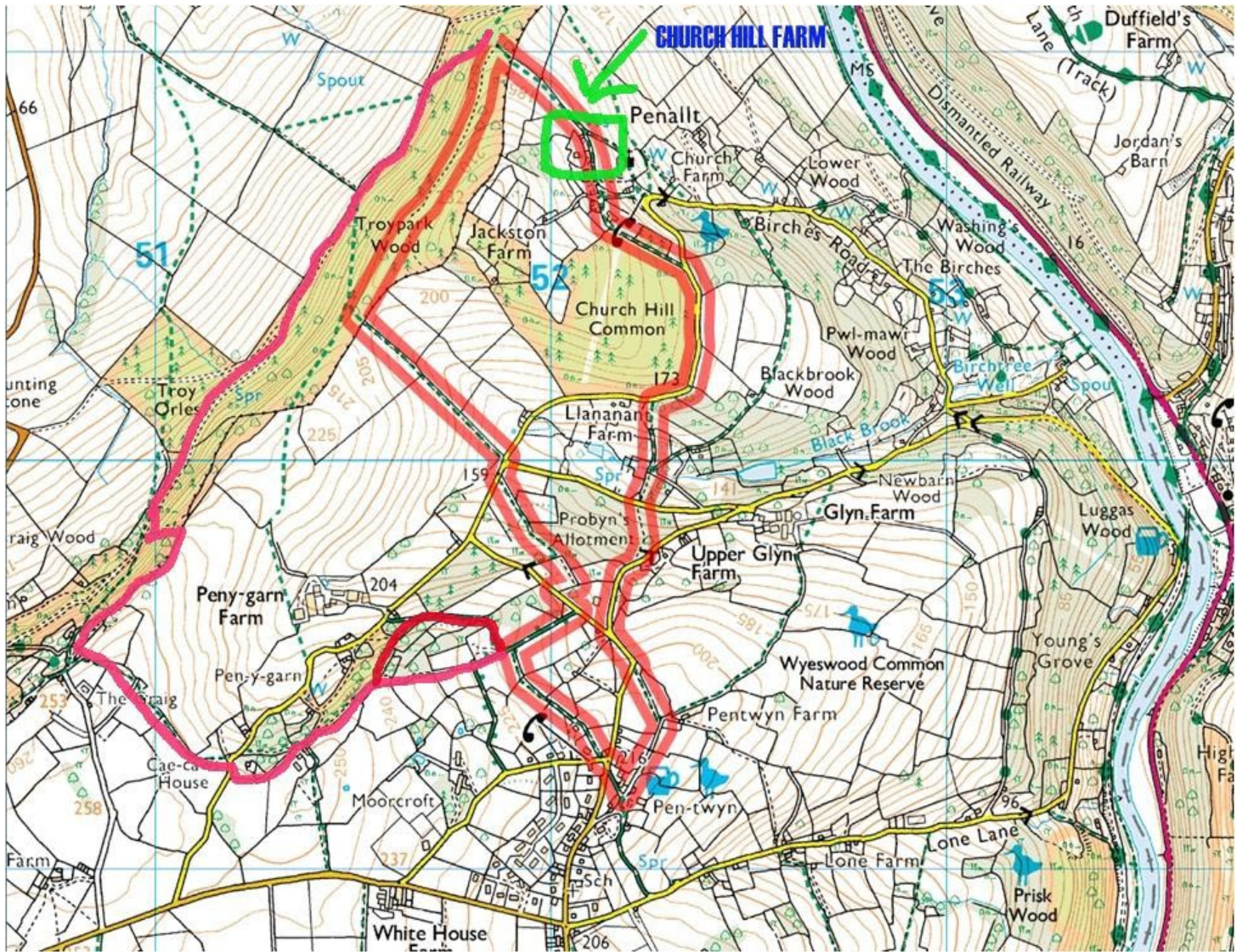
Take M4 to Newport and exit J24 onto the A449/A40 to Monmouth
Continue to Monmouth and exit to Trelleck immediately after the tunnel. At the mini roundabout by the Shell Petrol Station bear left and within a half mile bear left again onto the B4293 up the hill towards Trelleck. Almost at the brow of the hill you will see a turning off to the left to Penallt. Turn left here. Continue up this road bearing left until **THE FINAL PART** ◆◆◆

THE FINAL PART◆◆◆Now take the second left turn signposted to PENALLT OLD CHURCH. (N.B. Do not go into Penallt Village. If you pass the sign indicating the entrance to the village you have gone too far.)

Drive for 1.7 miles – you will now have the forest on your left and fields (with black sheep in them) on your right at Sunnybank Farm. On your left you will come to a forest track. Then, on your left, you will come to a forest track. At the end of this track there is a footpath sign to "Livox Wood and Troy" and a small sign for "Church Hill Farm" and "High View Barn". Turn left up this track and when you get to the **outbuildings** continue straight ahead. Do not take the left fork. Do not be put off by the state of the track, it is perfectly fine provided you go carefully and provided you do not drive a low slung sports car. You will first come to the house and just beyond is High View Barn on the right hand side with its own parking area.

Note that if you go too far you will come to Penallt Old Church where there is a phone box. The track to our farm is 400 metres up hill from the church.

Church Hill Farm and High View Barn Penallt The area highlighted in **bright green** is the location of the farm and barn. The red markings are interesting footpaths in the area with a number of options depending on how far you wish to walk.
